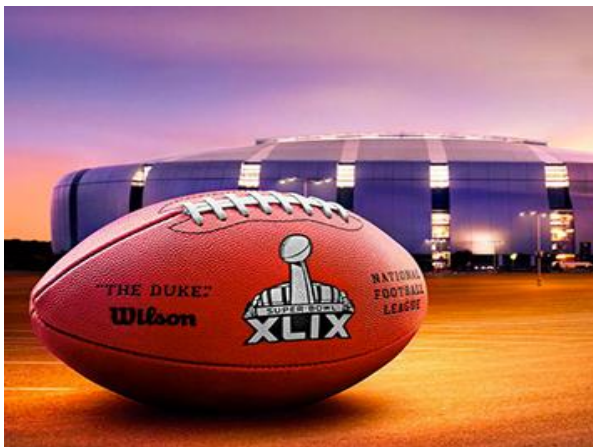
# Upcoming Events

## Here is what we believe:

1. We believe in one God, the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. (John 10:30, John 14:16-20)
