14 Years ago, my oldest sister (Lesa Bowley) continued in the hospital with a condition she had dealt with since the age of 14. She had cancer. After years of prayer, friends across the nation praying, and many family members praying, they found a matching heart for Lesa for a heart transplant. March 16, 2002, my 38 year old sister, underwent a surgery that no one can imagine, and had her heart transplant. My sister was to never have kids, She faced the odds, used her prayers, and had my niece (2 years older than me, married, and with 3 kids now). My sister went against the odds of the doctor's choice of abortion. Prayer works.

Almost 13 years later, and my sister is still running circles around our family, staying strong in her faith, praying ceaselessly, and staying very active with their church in Newburgh, Indiana at Crossroads Christian Church. How is she here today? How is she so active still? The average heart transplant patient only lives around 10-11 years after a transplant. She's already beaten the odds with almost 13 years. How? Prayer!

Prayer, like all things that come from God, is a gift. As Christians, we are entitled to pray.

Luke 18:1 says:

"Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up."

Never give up and always pray. That's quite a statement. God gives us tests like these from my family, often. It's not because he dislikes us or disapproves of our actions. We know we sin every day, and are not perfect, by any means. He's testing our fruits, and our faith. Our prayer lives are what gets us from day to day, heals the strong from being weak, heals the blind being able to see, causing the cancer to disappear, and the people's lives being saved from misery. Just through prayer alone, anything that we face, we can overcome and conquer.

Pray more, and complain less. Prayer can change this dark and dying world, not our mouths! It starts with us!
