## **SCIOTOVILLE CHRISTIAN MISSIONS REPORT**

Fundamentally, a sense of mission is essential for a church. All of us who now know Christ are the former recipients of mission efforts. Every church needs to hear that we are all participants in God’s eternal plan to redeem our neighborhoods and the entire world! Loving neighbors and helping others globally has and needs to be the nature of any church. An example of that can be seen in Acts 13, the church at Antioch. As a church serves its LOCAL needs, its members soon begin sending people to other places in a global sense. Matthew 24:14 states, that the “gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world for a witness to all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.” Luke 19:10 also instructs us to “save sinners.” Our equipment for our mission efforts include our prayers and our monetary support.

The church here at Sciotoville supports our eleven missions by setting aside \$165.00 each week from our weekly offerings. Our missions include three local efforts: HMCA, KCU, and our local college tuition efforts. The other eight mission efforts are global: James Dye Mission, Grundy Mountain School, Reaching Out for Christ Ministries, Osaka Bible Seminary, TCM International, I.D.E.S. (emergency efforts all over the U.S. and globe), Central Brazil Mission and Central Christian College.

10. *We observe the Lord's Supper each week in remembrance of His death, His resurrection, and His promised return. (I Corinthians 11:23-32, Acts 20:7)*
