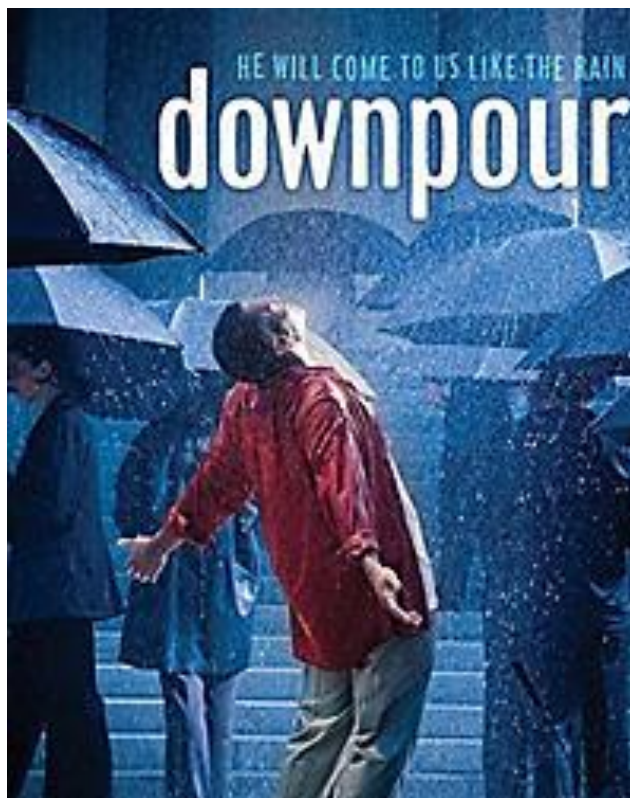

# Our Beliefs

## ***Here is what we believe:***

- 1. We believe in one God, the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. (John 10:30, John 14:16-20)*

- 8. That the Church is the family of God here on earth, and exists to share God's love with the lost, and continue to mature the faith of those that are in a right relationship with God. (Ephesians 4:11-16)*
- 9. That every member of this church has gifts given to them by God, so that they can use those gifts to help build up His Church on earth. (Romans 12:3-8, I Peter 4:10-11)*
- 10. We observe the Lord's Supper each week in remembrance of His death, His resurrection, and His promised return. (I Corinthians 11:23-32, Acts 20:7)*
