MISSION HIGHLIGHTS “Operation Christmas Child”

More than 80,000 churches across the United States are involved in packing gifts for Operation Christmas Child. There are just as many churches worldwide handing them out. We rejoice to hear how God is using shoebox gifts and The Greatest Journey around the world to grow congregations, strengthen evangelistic outreach, and even plant new churches.

Karen Humphrey coordinates our efforts here at Sciotoville Christian with this mission endeavor. Each shoebox we pack is a missionary to children in 118 countries receiving shoebox gifts through Operation Christmas Child, including more than a million children in countries that we can't name for security reasons. Operation Christmas Child collected 7,991,643 shoeboxes gifts in the United States, plus another 2,448,690 from Austria, Australia, Canada, Finland, Germany, Japan, Spain, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.

Our shoebox gifts help to: Share the Good News of Jesus Christ; bless children with joy, hope, and love; give a church an effective outreach tool; make disciples through the local church; multiply as children share their faith with friends and family; and grow congregations and plant new churches worldwide. What comes out of the shoeboxes is *eternal*.

This mission effort helps us to carry out the “Great Commission,” to “go *therefore*, and make disciples of all the nations.” (Matthew 28:19)

Here is what we believe:

8. *That the Church is the family of God here on earth, and exists to share God's love with the lost, and continue to mature the faith of those that are in a right relationship with God. (Ephesians 4:11-16)*
9. *That every member of this church has gifts given to them by God, so that they can use those gifts to help build up His Church on earth. (Romans 12:3-8, I Peter 4:10-11)*
10. *We observe the Lord's Supper each week in remembrance of His death, His resurrection, and His promised return. (I Corinthians 11:23-32, Acts 20:7)*
